Yamaha, Husky Sport, Husaberg, Suzuki, Honda, Kawasaki, KTM, BMW, CCM, Sherco, Gas-Gas and Scorpia are just a few who have committed to attending this year's show and displaying their all new 2009 products for the first time in the UK this year.

Yamaha will be launching their new YZ250F and YZ450F Motocross bikes and their new 2009 YFZ450R Sport Quad and the YFM250 WVTA Sport Quad. Also on their stand (Hall 2, A02) the all new YZ450 TR, which is the Monster Factory Team Replica, a special limited edition with only 100 official models being made, this is to celebrate the MX1 World Championship win, it includes factory Yamaha team plastics and graphics along with carbon fibre protection accessories and a signed Phillipaerts race shirt, each bike will be individually numbered.

Kawasaki (Hall 2, A10) will be launching their new 2009 KXF250 and KXF450, these two 4-stroke machines have been given a new look and some major changes for 2009.
